This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 12 only. Any further increase in sections strictly shall only be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws and subject to the availability of infrastructure and room size of 500> sqr ft.
2	CwSN toilets are not arranged properly as per the statutory provisions of RPwD, Act 2016 and the Board guidelines vide circular no 05/2023 (https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf). The entrance of the toilets is narrow for navigation of wheelchair inside. The side bars/hand rail supports on the side of the commodes are small and affixed at distance. Further the hand rails are not fixed at suitable distance also to make the proper use by the CwSN. School should follow the circular no 05/2023 and the guidelines to ensure the campus accessible to CwSN in compliance of statutory provisions and shall upload the compliance with you tube video link on SARAS portal within 03 months.

3	The composite science lab is under stocked and has only one table to be used as work/station and Demonstration table. No other fixtures except wash basins are available on the table. The heating facility/gas connection is temporary with small gas cylinder which is not safe as per SoPs (circular no 11/2022). No seating arrangement for users is available. School shall develop and upgrade the lab accordingly and shall submit the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
4	School has no lift/ramp to access the upper floors and has undertaken to complete the same. School has undertaken to install the same within 02 months. School is directed to install the lift as undertaken and upload the compliance on SARAS portal with video link within 03 months.
5	Temporary paper signage is affixed at classrooms, Labs, toilets etc. There should be permanent signage at all prominent places as per the rule 4.7 of the affiliation bye laws. School shall affix the permanent signage at all the prominent places in the school campus and shall upload the compliance on saras portal within 03 months.
6	The mathematics lab is not arranged as per Board guidelines and SoPs vide circular no 11/2022. It looks like a temporary arrangement with equipment/kits and models displayed on tables of different sizes placed along the walls. There are no work spaces for students with proper seating and storage. School is directed to upgrade the lab and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
7	The library also should be upgraded with addition of more infrastructure like collection of classics, autobiographies, biographies, travelogues, essays, fiction, poetry, drama, recreational and motivational materials and with Information Communication Technology Infrastructure & software for online learning. The books are not properly catalogued and arranged in book shelves for library operations. The school should comply with circular no 11/2022 and upload the compliance on SARAS portal with video link within 03 months.
8	The school has no sufficient indoor and outdoor sports facilities. There is solid and marked floor/court for basketball, volleyball or any other games. The ground is uneven and underdeveloped with loose and muddy soil without proper marking on the ground. Only one single volleyball net without painted mark/markings is seen. For indoor sports only few chess and carom board with one TT are available. School should upgrade the sports facilities as per circular no 11/2022 and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
9	The access to the school is not through solid concrete road. The passage connected to the school is uneven with muddy soil and not accessible during the rainy season. Further, the school has a large katcha ground/compound which would hamper the accessibility of staff and students, particularly the CwSN, during the rainy season as there is no solid pavement from school gate to the ramp at the school entrance. Accessibility to the school is not easy, smooth and proper. School should arrange for required infrastructure and facilities as per Affiliation bye laws, 2018 (rule 4.7.6) and safety norms and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
10	School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from CoE, Pune within 03 months and shall upload the compliance on SARAS portal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye - Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
